



Codes of Conduct Administration / Officials

- X Ensure that equal opportunity for participation in sports are made available to all children, regardless of ability, size, shape, sex, age, disability or ethnic origin.
- X Ensure that rules, equipment, length of games and training schedules take into consideration the age, ability and maturity level of participating children.
- X Ensure that adequate supervision is provided by qualified and competent coaches and officials capable of developing appropriate sports behaviour and skill technique.
- X Remember that children participate for enjoyment and play down the importance of rewards.
- X Provide clinics aimed at improving the standards of coaching and officiating, with an emphasis on appropriate behaviour and skill technique.
- X Ensure that parents, coaches, sponsors, physicians and participants understand their responsibility regarding fair play.
- X Modify rules and regulations to match the skill level of children and their needs.
- X Condemn unsporting behaviour and promote respect for all opponents.
- X Publicly encourage rule changes which will reinforce the principles of participants for fun and enjoyment.
- X Ensure that your behaviour is consistent with the principles of good sporting behaviour.
- X Make a personal commitment to keep yourself informed of sound officiating principles and the principles of growth and development of children.

Codes of Conduct Players

- X Play by the rules.
- X Never argue with an official. If you disagree, discuss the matter with your coach after the game.
- X Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, or provoking an opponent is not acceptable.
- X Work equally hard for yourself and/or for you team. Your team=s performance will benefit, so will you.
- X Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they be by your team, opponent or other team.
- X Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- X Co-operate with your coach, umpire, team mates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- X Play for the Afun of it@ and not just to please parents and coaches.
- X Avoid using derogatory language.
