



First Aid Officials

(Rule 18.3)

18.3.1 Policy

While it is the home teams responsibility to provide a First Aid Attendant, it will be the visiting team officials ie Coach/Manager responsibility to check with the home team that in fact such a person is on duty and qualified.

The persons name must be on the AFL Brisbane Juniors team sheet in the space provided.

If a qualified First Aid Attendant is not present then it is the duty of the visiting team officials to report to the Central Umpire.

A period of 15 minutes will take place for the home team to provide this person, if at this time the situation remains the same the visiting team can provide a qualified First Aid Attendant and they can commence.

If no Qualified First Aid Attendant is available the game will not commence under any circumstances.

The Central Umpire will declare the game a forfeit and advise the AFL Brisbane Juniors.

18.3.2 Fines

18.3.3 If first aid is needed and the advise is that the player shall not continue playing, the Coach shall abide by the decision of the Qualified First Aid Official.

18.3.4 Each oval must have a qualified 1st Aid Official, 1st Aid Kit and a stretcher
